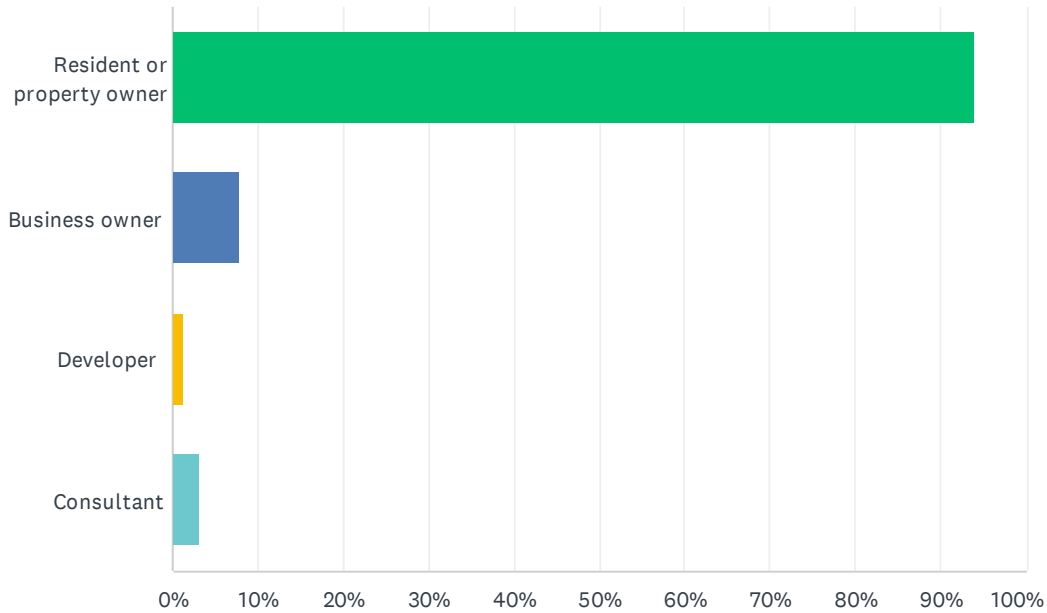


# Q1 In what capacity do you use the McKinney development regulations? (check all that apply)

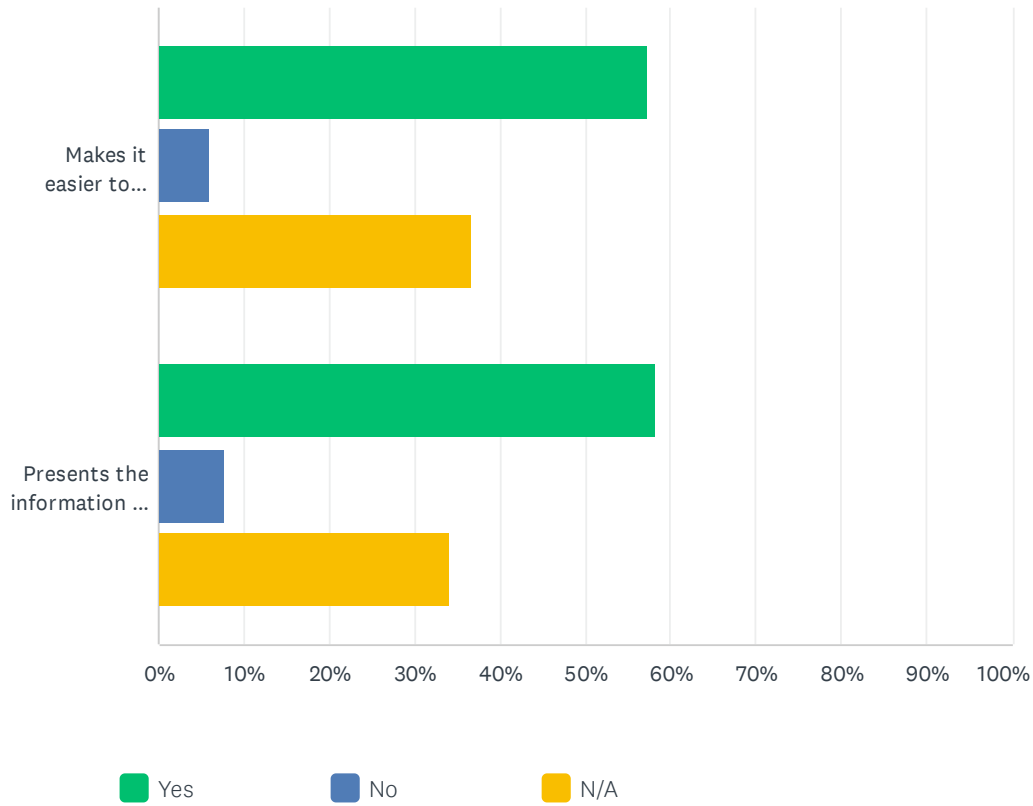

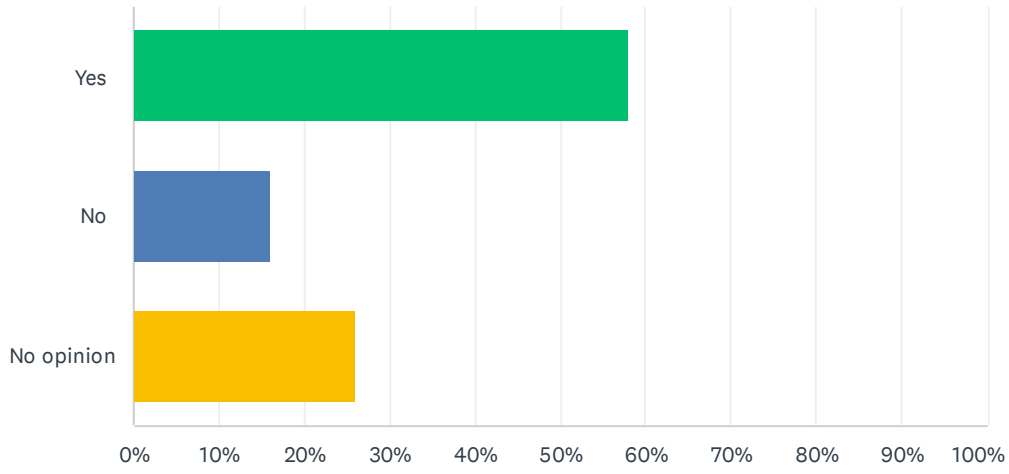

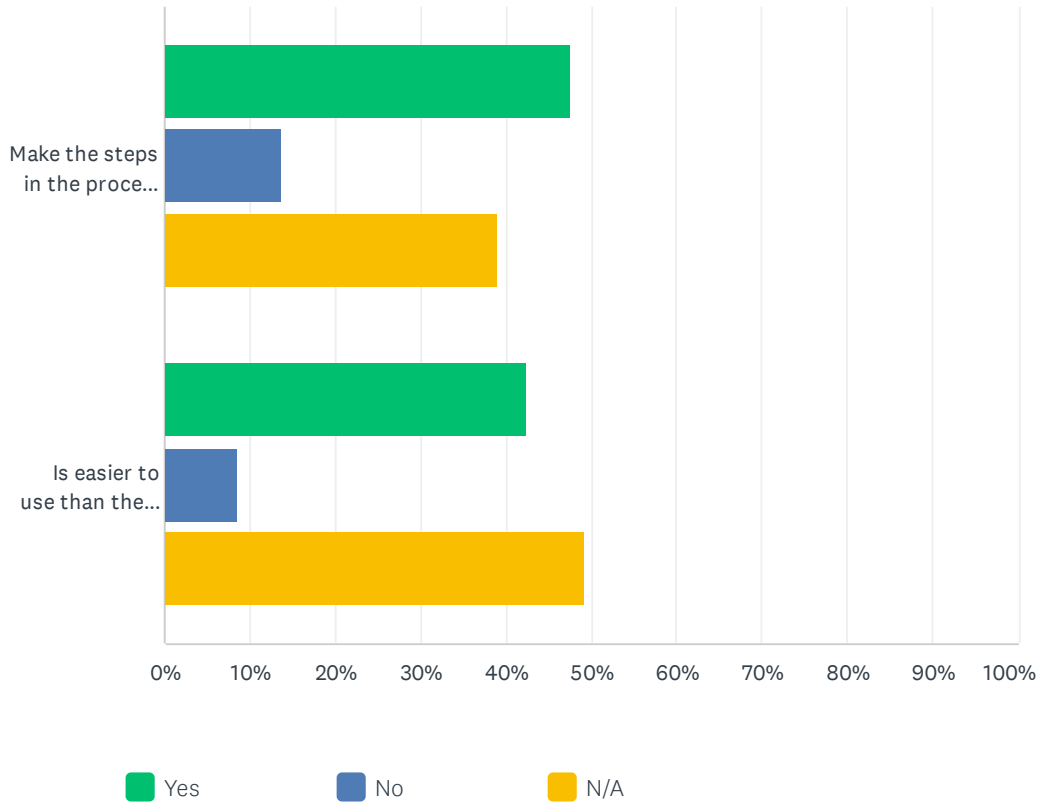

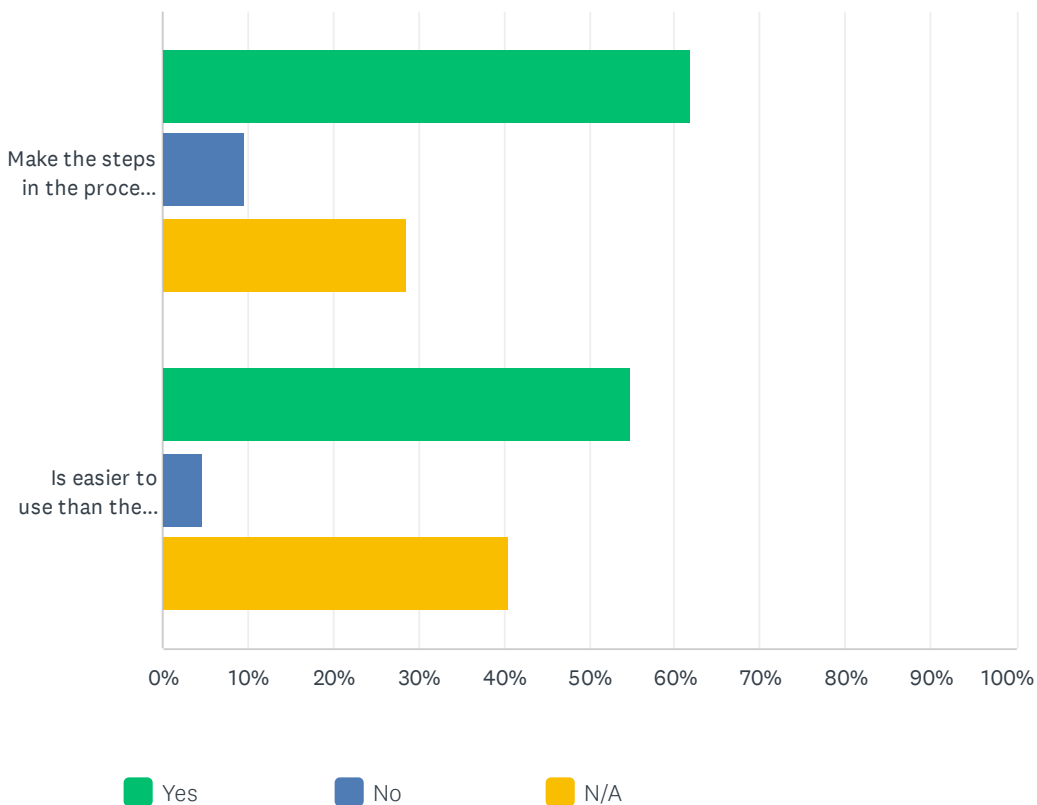

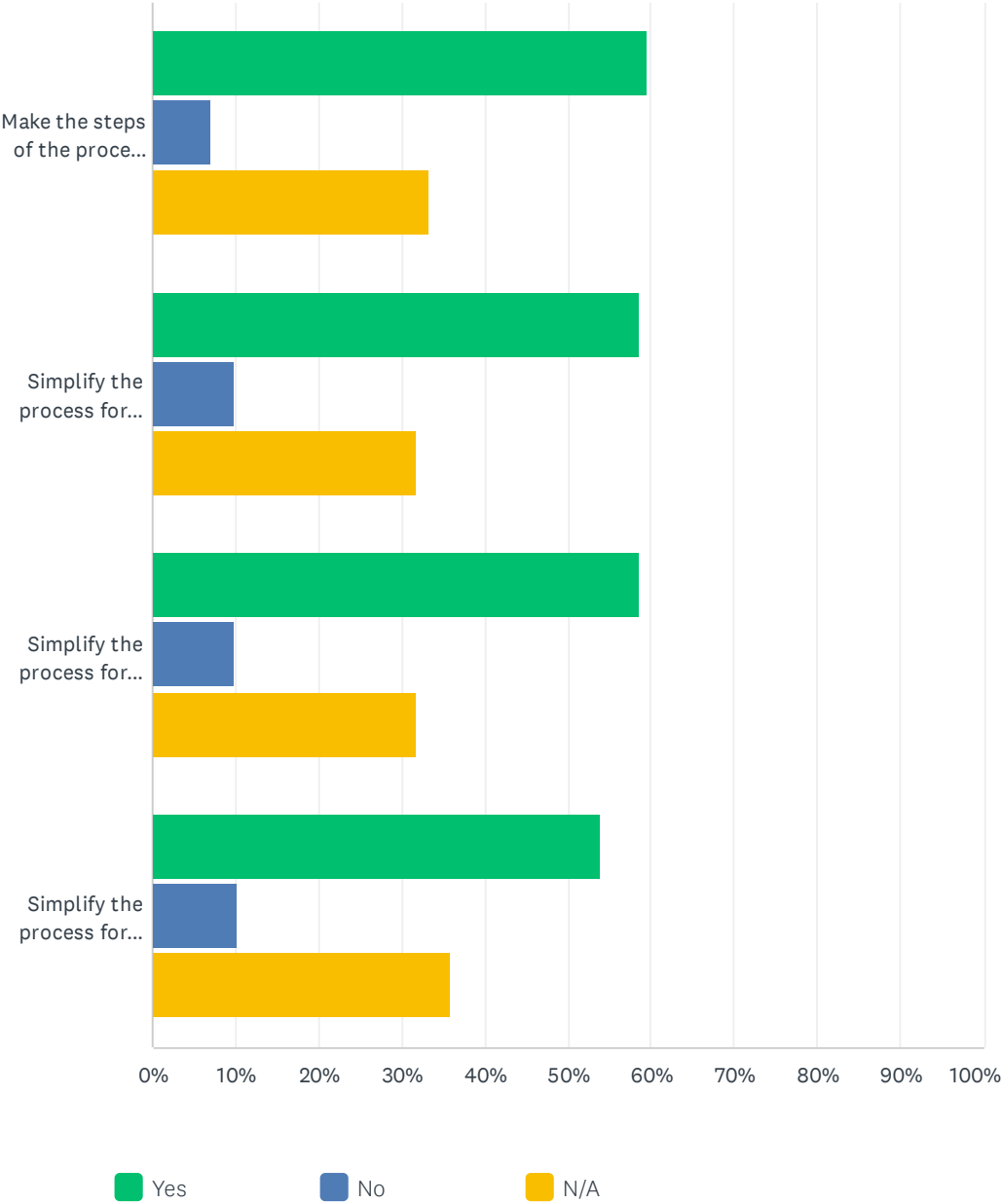
